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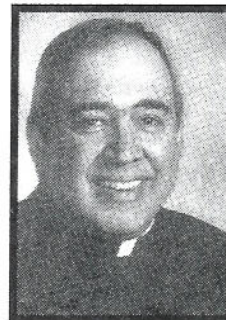

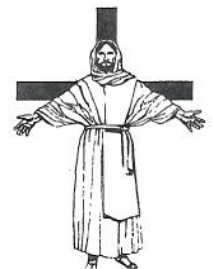

Kathleen McCarthy . . . President of In His Sign Network a radio and communications ministry comprised of lay Catholics proclaiming the Good News of Jesus Christ. Kathleen has spoken at various conferences and facilitates parish renewals, retreats, workshops and days of renewal. She is a published author and radio broadcaster.

Father Urban Hudlin, O.P. . . . Father Urban has served as an Associate Pastor, Presenter of bible reflections on Nation Television Network, Vicariate Council for the Dominican Order, Moderator of the Catholic Charismatic Renewal of Trinidad and Tobago and has preached in England, Ireland, Africa, Canada and the Caribbean.

Msr. Joseph Malagrega . . . Presently Pastor of Holy Cross Parish in Brooklyn. He has spent much of his priesthood with immigrant groups from Latin America and Haiti; he is fluent in Spanish, French, Haitian Creole and Italian. He is Coordinator of the Charismatic Renewal for Hispanic and Haitian prayer groups in the diocese of Brooklyn. He has served as past Chairperson for the Steering Committee for the National Association of Diocesan Laisons.

Father Richard MacAlear, OMI . . . Father MacAlear, became involved in the Catholic Charismatic Renewal in 1972 and he entered into the healing ministry in 1976. His ministry and work have brought him to every part of the United States and various other countries. He has been a member of the Association of Christian Therapists since 1977. He served as Vocation Director for the Oblates of Mary Immaculate and upon completion of his term as Vocation Director he devoted himself full time to teaching and the healing ministry.
