



Week 7: Transformation – Pat Mackey











Transformation is a change of identity... in the deepest part of our being. Being a Child of the Spirit is now your primary identification.

Your transformation is going to arrive in many different ways. At one time through your emotions or feelings... a scripture passage... a praise song...







Charisms are defined as extraordinary power given by the Holy Spirit for the good of the church.














Questions To Consider
